Background

- CENTCOM Policy Letter #40:

Purpose – Expand economic partnership with the Central Asian States (CAS) in support of security cooperation and engagement missions and enable access to and expansion of capacity of the Northern Distribution Network in support of OEF

- DLA Prime Vendor Model – *Seven Seas Shipchangers (SSS) and Theodor Wille Intertrade (TWI)*
- DLA Market Surveys and Site Visits
 - ▶ More than 40 construction material manufacturers visited
 - ▶ Materials and equipment are GOST standards
 - ▶ Significant capacity exists within region to produce a wide variety construction materials





DLA Support to USACE Construction Program

- Government Furnished Materials/Equipment – Identified in project RFP under Spec Section 1701
 - ▶ Items will be ordered based on BOM submitted by Prime 30 to 90 days after NTP
 - ▶ USACE will pay for materials through a funds transfer to DLA
 - ▶ Material cost not included in contract award to Prime

- Contractor Purchased Materials through DLA
 - ▶ Contractor identifies material quantities and orders directly from DLA
 - ▶ Contractor pays DLA for materials
 - ▶ Material cost included in contract award to Prime
 - ▶ Requires Prime Contractor to have project specific DODAAC





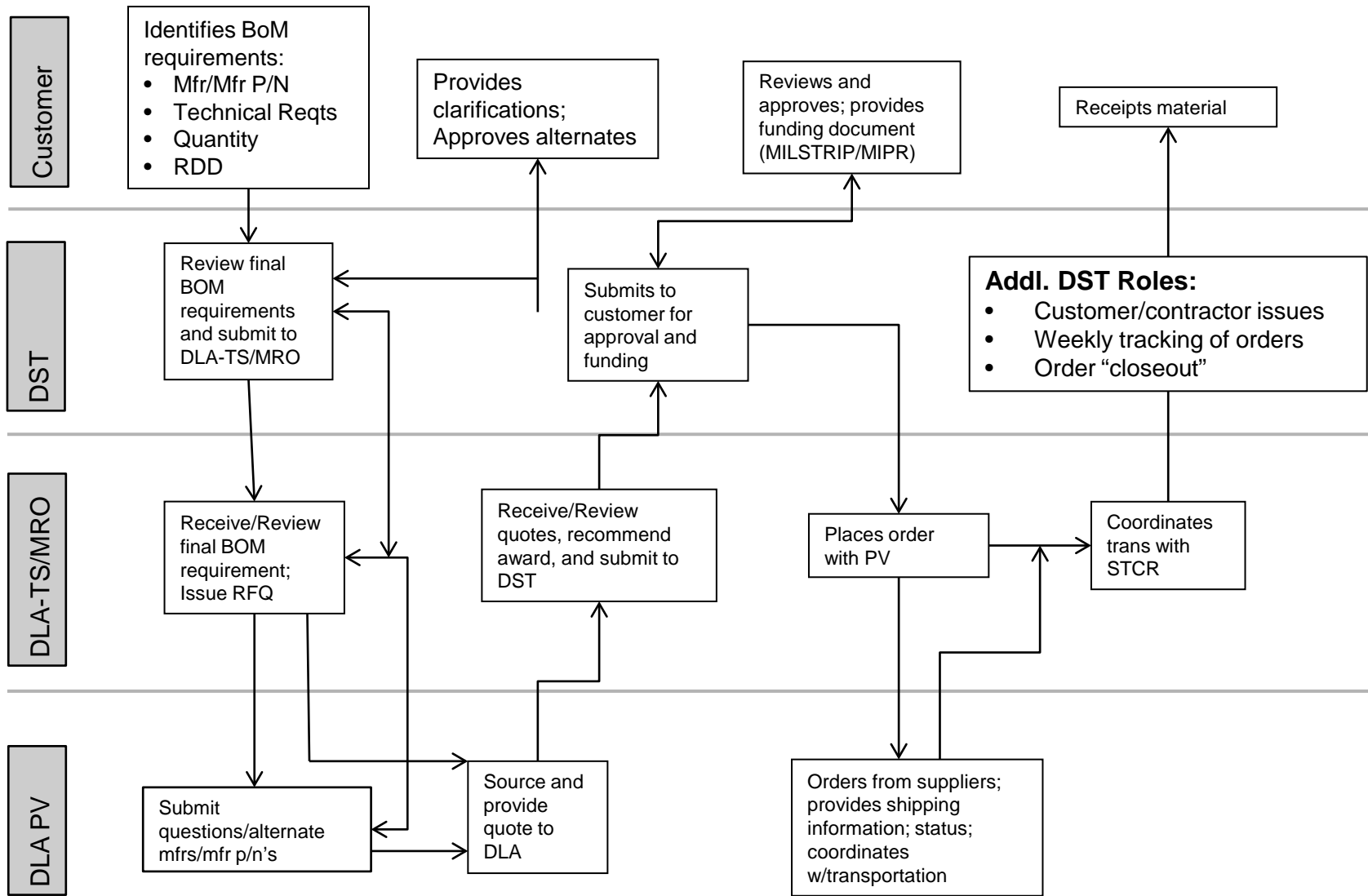
Benefits of Procuring Materials through DLA

- Government shipment of materials
- Ship directly from factory to project site
- Material made to regional specifications and known standards
- Materials may be less expensive than equivalent U.S. or European items
- Replacement parts, equipment and technical support available in the region
- Eliminates Pakistan border crossing issues





Process for Contractor to Purchase Materials through DLA





Government Procured Material and Equipment in CAS

- Items currently procured in the region by DLA to support operations to date:

Dimensional lumber	Ready-mix Concrete	Packaged generator units
Plywood	55 gal fuel drums	Transformers
Roofing felt	Wood pallets	Rolled steel for arch-span
Corrugated metal roofing	Concertina wire	Electrical wire and cable

- Items DLA is prepared to procure if requisitions are received:

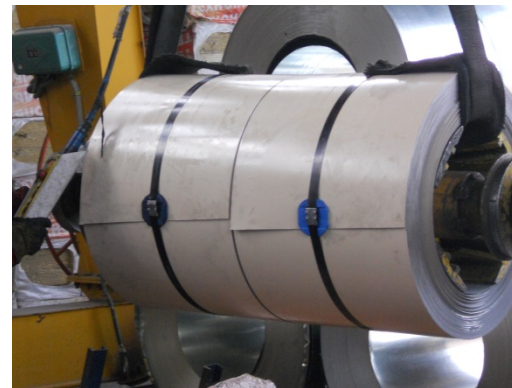


CAS Available Items

- Plywood – various grades/sizes
- Lumber – construction grade; untreated
 - ▶ 5510-01-607-9425 – 2"x4"x16'(20')
 - ▶ 5510-01-607-9427 – 2"x6"x16'(20')
 - ▶ 5510-01-607-9430 – 2"x10"x16'(20')
 - ▶ 5510-01-607-9431 – 2"x12"x16'(20')
 - ▶ 5510-01-607-9434 – 4"x4"x16'(20')
 - ▶ 5510-01-607-9436 – 2"x8"x16' (20')

- Steel Coil
 - ▶ 1mm tested and approved
 - ▶ 1.5mm pending

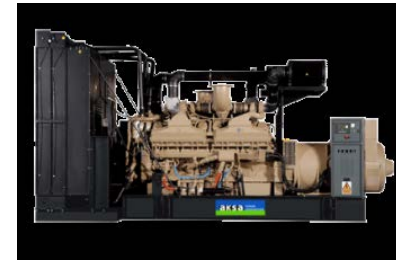

CAS Available Items

- Initial product specifications approved by USACE
 - ▶ Generators – 1000kVA; 1600kVA
 - ▶ Transformers – 300kVA; 500kVA
 - ▶ Cable – 12-20kV Feeder Cable
 - ▶ Water Heaters – 450L Capacity
- Fuel Drums





CAS Available Items

Cement/Rebar

- Tested at U.S. laboratory
 - Cement conforms to ASTM C150-11 Standard for Portland Cement
 - Rebar conforms to ASTM-A-370-010/ASTM-A-706-09
- Pre-positioned stock at Defense Distribution Kandahar
 - Cement - 10,000 110-lb. bags
 - CEMENT-50KG-PC400 5610-01-610-3981
 - CEMENT-1 MT-PC400 5610-01-610-3983
